Local Community Speedwatch – Volunteers Wanted

Did you know that we operate a community Speedwatch with council staff, councillors and local volunteers to monitor the speeds of passing vehicles at risk assessed locations. This is run in conjunction with Kent Police and volunteers capture and report details of vehicles travelling above the speed limit. The registered keepers of vehicles observed repeatedly or excessively speeding anywhere in the county are then sent advice by Kent Police. We require more volunteers in Westerham and Crockham Hill! If you are interested in volunteering, you would need to complete an online course (45 mins) and undertake training at a Speedwatch sessions (all sessions run for one hour).
